We have had another year with full Breeding Health and Welfare Commission, thank you to Margaret, Andrea, Vicki and Glenn for their hard work.

We are still seeing several litters being registered after 8 months of age, which is in breach of Felis Britannica Registration rule 2.2.10 and a couple of breeches of FIFe rule 5.1.1. Thankfully the number of cases that requiring referring to the DCO where litters have been registered after 8 months of age has reduced. The cases of breeches of FIFe rule 5.1.1 where cats were registered in another registry first, were mainly from one member club however review of their membership application process identified that they were making prospective members fully aware that they must follow all Felis Britannica and FIFe rules.

We were able again attend The Cat Show Live and The Supreme Cat show and talk to the public about FIFe and the safeguards buying a registered pedigree came with. We were also able to show off our certified pedigrees, and garnered interest from breeders and exhibitors as well as the general public. We have also reviewed the applications and the registrar has issued a number of show licences.

We have reviewed the progress of the breeding programme that a Felis Britannica Club member is undertaking to breed Tiffanie's, which are a non recognised sister breed of the Burmilla.

We were pleased to see that CORIN gained preliminary recognition, as we have a number of breeders who were working with the unrecognised variety.

We are lucky to have Vicki Adam's a vet as part of our BH&W commission and following feedback we have developed a new vetting in pack for vets which was tried at the Felis Britannica Winners show and will be sent out for review.

We were approached as a commission via the general secretary from a councils Animal Health & Welfare Officer to ask what health checks, we as a registry body required our members to adhere to and the maximum allowable number of litters a queen was allowed to have.
